TOPIC/EQUIPMENT: Don Personal Protective Clothing - Wildland Fire

CATEGORY: Performance Examination

POINTS POSSIBLE: 100

TIME ALLOWED: 60 seconds

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:

Condition: A full set of wildland fire personal protective clothing

Behavior: The student will don the wildland fire personal protective clothing under simulated fire conditions while wearing the CDF work uniform.

Standard: With a minimum of 70% accuracy, within 60 seconds, according to the job breakdown

- MATERIALS NEEDED:**
- One (1) Set of Wildland Fire Personal Protective Clothing Per Student
 - One (1) Stop Watch
 - One (1) Score Sheet Per Student
 - One (1) Manipulative Performance Test Cover Page
 - One (1) Clip Board
 - One (2) Red Pen

- PROCEDURES:**
- The student will fully don the wildland fire personal protective clothing within the time allotted
 - The examination and time will start when the student either verbally or by conduct performs any step of the performance examination.

SCORING:

Points will be deducted for each step omitted, performed improperly, or performed out of sequence. Steps designated by an asterisk (*) must be performed properly or the student fails the entire examination. If the student goes over the allotted time he/she will fail the entire examination.

SPECIAL NOTES:

Before the examination begins the student will be allowed to ask any clarifying questions and inspect the equipment. The clothing will be laid out on a flat surface, and the student will be wearing the CDF work uniform including lugged sole boots, and cotton T-shirt (work shirt is optional).

Once the examination begins, the exam proctor shall not answer any questions or intercede in any way, unless safety violations occur that would injure personnel or damage equipment. Prior to entering the examination area the student will be wearing the CDF work uniform, including lugged sole boots.
