FIREFIGHTER SAFETY

TOPIC: How To Use The One-Piece - Roll Down Fire Resistive Curtain

LEVEL OF INSTRUCTION: II

TIME FRAME: 20 Minutes

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:

Condition: A CDF fire engine with a one-piece roll down fire resistive curtain

Behavior: The student will deploy the one-piece fire resistive roll down fire curtain under simulated fire conditions, while wearing full wildland fire personal protective clothing.

Standard: With a minimum 70% accuracy, within 20 seconds, according to the job breakdown

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- CDF fire engine with a one-piece roll down fire resistive curtain
- Stop Watch
- Job Breakdown
- one set of Wildland Personal Protective Clothing per student

REFERENCES:

- None

PREPARATION: When a CDF fire engine is driven through fire or is overrun by fire, the wildland fire personal protective clothing does not offer adequate protection from radiant heat. In an effort to improve radiant heat shielding, CDF fire engines are equipped with fire resistive curtains. All firefighters should be trained to properly deploy fire resistive curtains.

| 1. Release fire resistive curtain fasteners | 1a. All fasteners and ties
b. With either hand
c. While seated |
| 2. Unroll fire resistive curtain | 2a. To full down position
b. Using both hands
c. While seated |
| 3. Cover side vents and side windows | 3a. Of crew compartment
b. With fire resistive curtains
c. Fully |
| 4. Anchor bottom of fire resistive curtain | 4a. To floor
b. With both feet
c. Toes on bottom edges of fire resistive curtain |
| 5. Grasp bottom corners of fire resistive curtain | 5a. With both hands |
| 6. Pull bottom corners of fire resistive curtain | 6a. Towards feet
b. Behind feet and legs |
| 7. Anchor bottom edges of fire resistive curtain | 7a. With both feet
b. With both legs
c. To floor and base of seat |
| 8. Seal fire resistive curtain openings | 8a. Protecting body parts
b. Eliminating all openings
c. Closing off heat access |
| 9. Grasp handhold | 9a. With both hands
b. Head towards either side |
| 10. Lie on seat | 10a. Upper torso on seat |
| 11. Hold fire resistive curtain | 11a. Maintaining handhold
b. Maintaining foot position |
