FIREFIGHTER SAFETY

**TOPIC/EQUIPMENT:** Use The Two-Piece Fire Resistive Curtain

**CATEGORY:** Performance Examination

**POINTS POSSIBLE:** 100

**TIME ALLOWED:** 20 Seconds

**BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:**

*Condition:* A CDF fire engine with two piece fire resistive curtain

*Behavior:* The student will deploy the two piece fire resistive curtain under simulated fire conditions, while wearing full wildland fire personal protective clothing.

*Standard:* With a minimum 70% accuracy, within 20 seconds, according to the score sheet

**MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- One (1) CDF Fire Engine with Two Piece Fire Resistive Curtain
- One (1) Set of Wildland Fire Personal Protective Clothing Per Student
- One (1) Stop Watch
- One (1) Score Sheet Per Student
- One (1) Manipulative Performance Test Cover Page
- One (1) Clip Board
- One (1) Red Pen

**PROCEDURES:**

- The examination and time will start when the student either verbally or by conduct performs any step of the performance examination.

**SCORING:**

Points will be deducted for each step omitted, performed improperly, or performed out of sequence. Steps designated by an asterisk (\*) must be performed properly or the student fails the entire examination. If the student goes over the allotted time he/she will fail the entire test.

	<u>POINTS</u>
1. Release fire curtain fasteners	<u>5</u>
A. Detach all fasteners and ties	<u>5</u>
B. While remaining seated	<u>*</u>
2. Grasp fire curtain handholds	<u>10</u>
A. Near top of fire curtains	<u>10</u>
B. While remaining seated	<u>*</u>
3. Close fire curtains	<u>10</u>
4. Use fire curtain to fully cover side vents and side windows in crew compartment	<u>*</u>
5. Anchor bottom edge of fire resistive curtains	<u>10</u>
A. One foot on each curtain	<u>10</u>
6. Gather and anchor fire curtain edges	<u>10</u>
A. Pulling towards feet	<u>10</u>
B. Using feet and legs to anchor edges to floor and seat base	<u>*</u>
C. Grasping both middle handholds in one hand and the lower handholds in the free hand	<u>*</u>
7. Ensure fire curtain fully sealed	<u>*</u>
